Usually, if you are in a big city, there's a good chance the doctor will speak English. However, knowing basic words to describe your symptoms will make it so much easier for you to get the help you need.

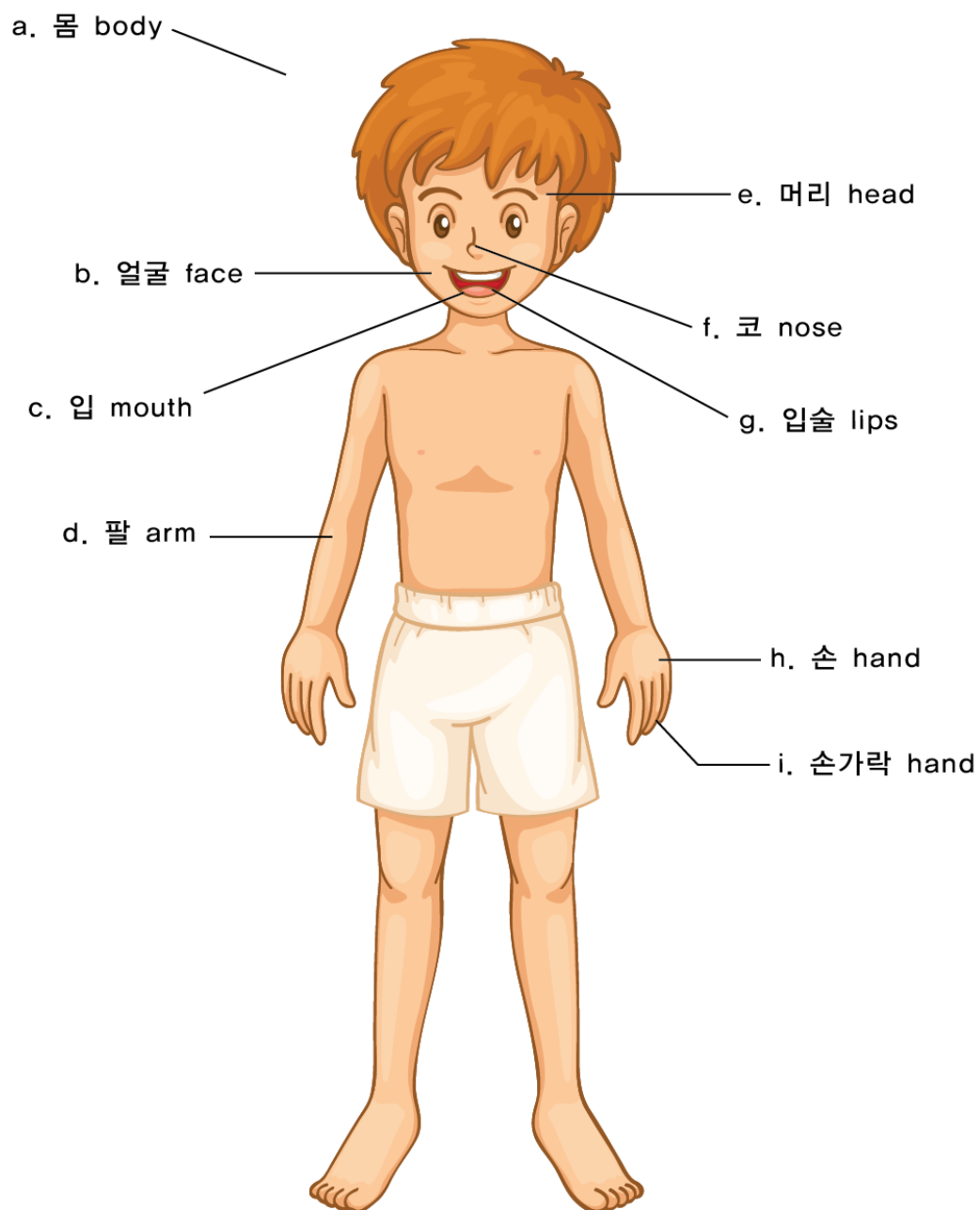

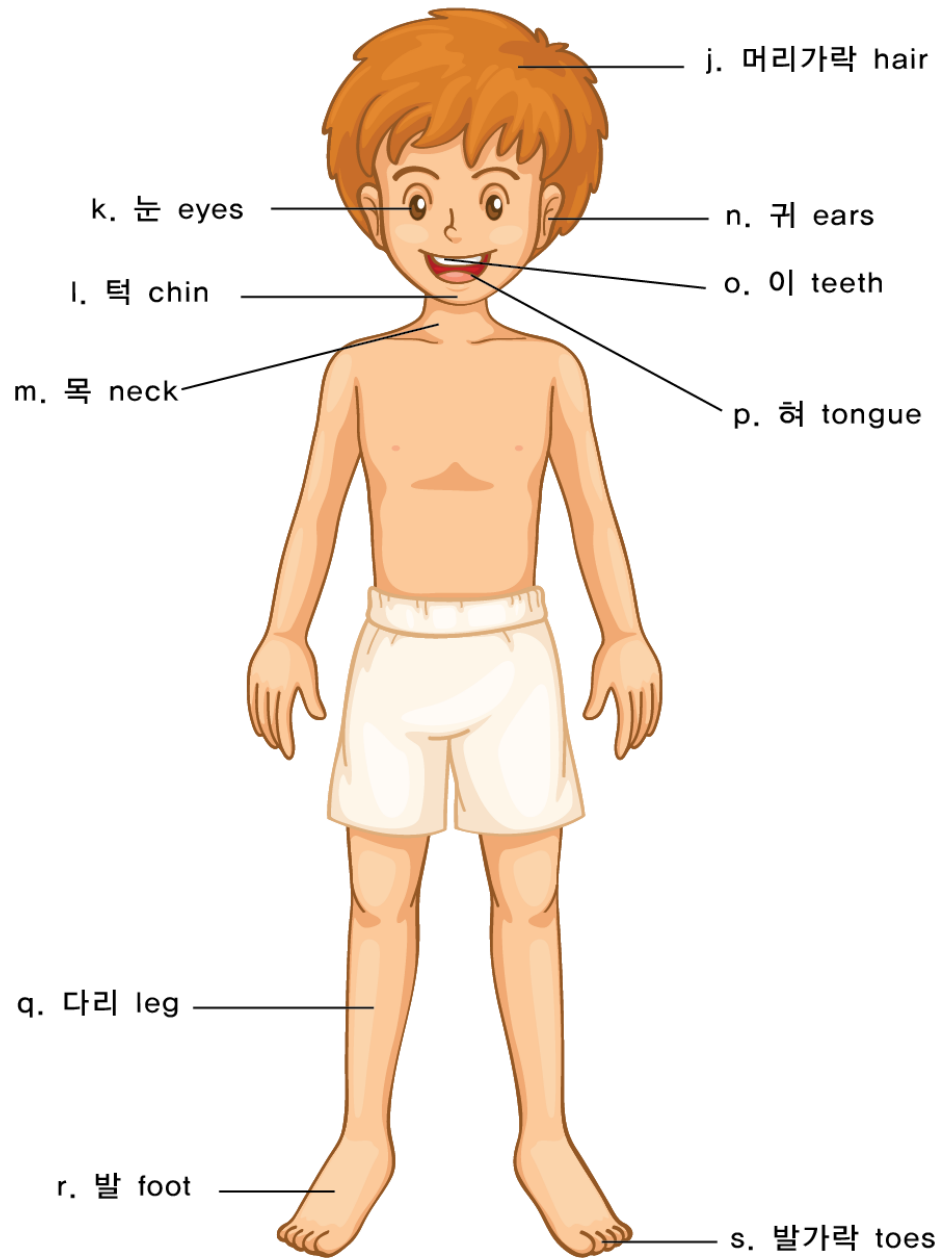

Simply give the pharmacist the paper, and they will bring you the medicine you need.

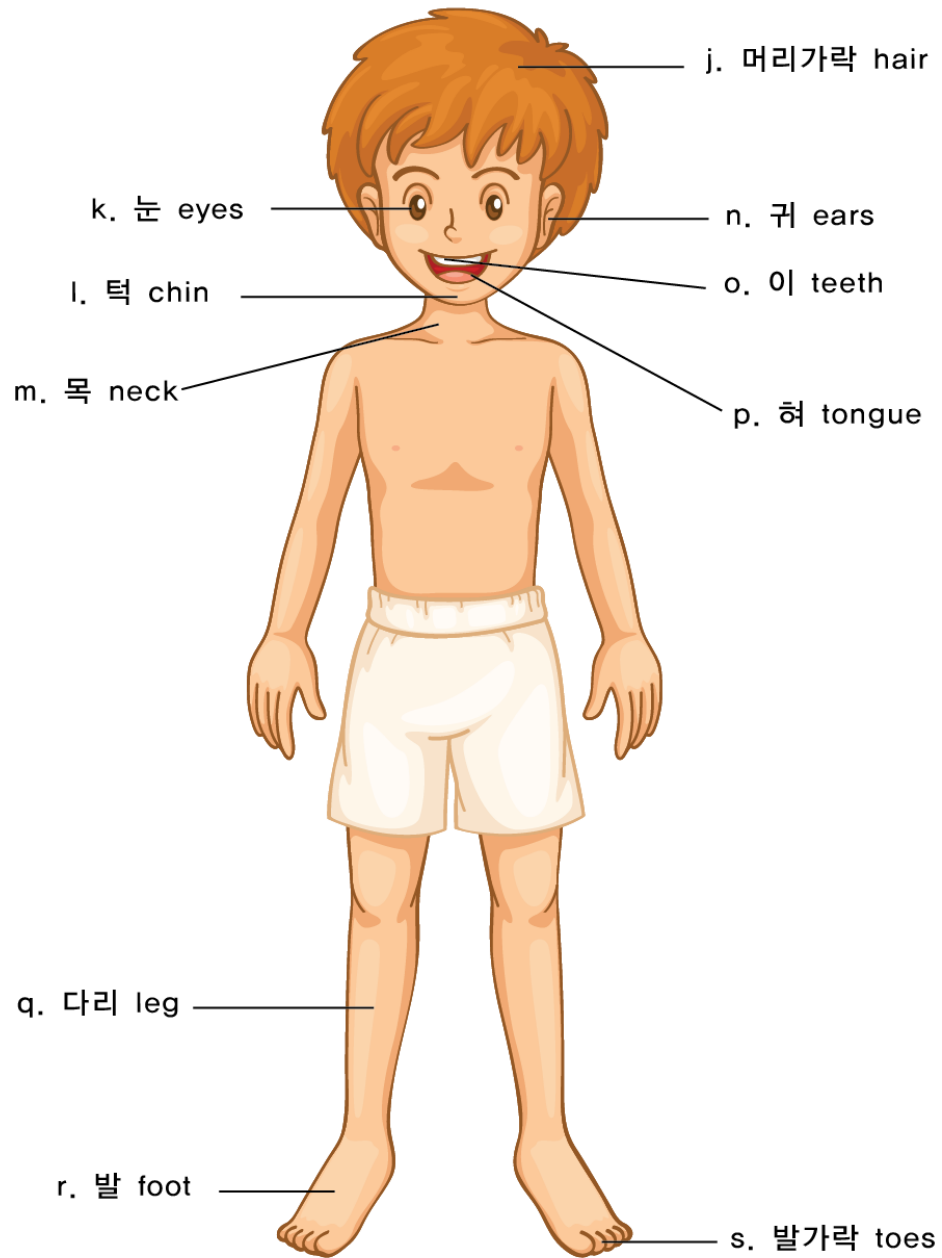

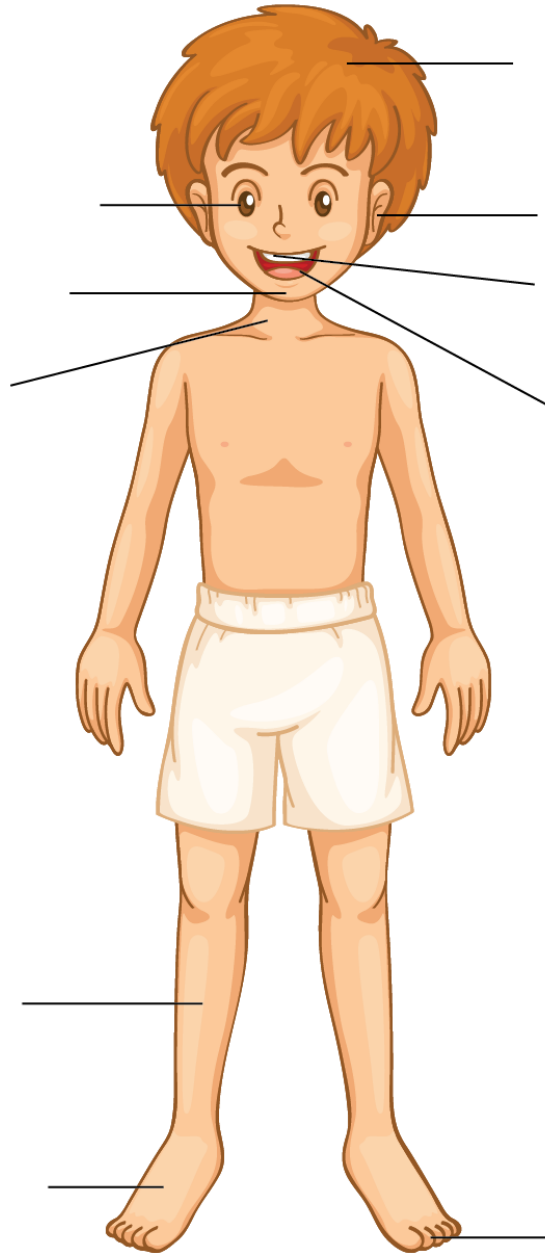

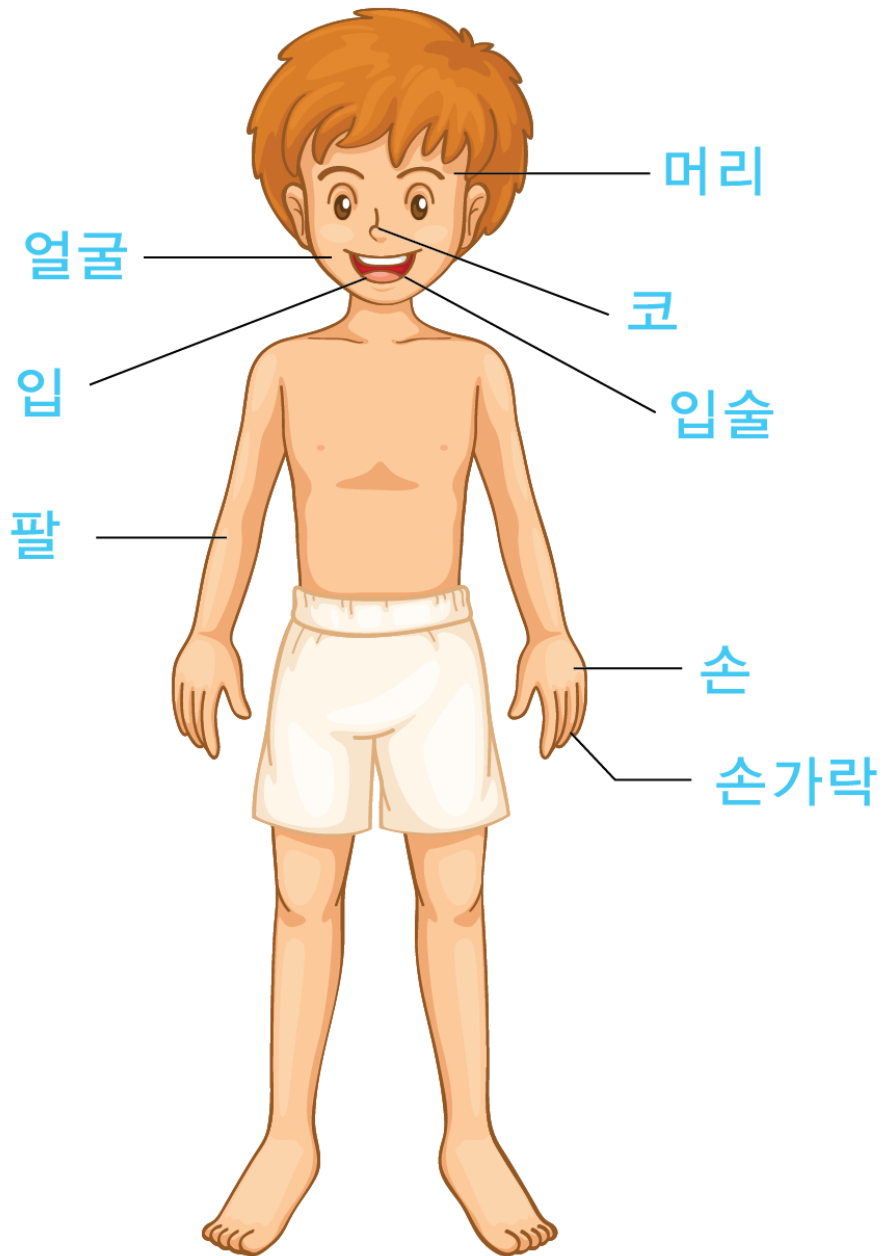
